We are strictly a “drop off and pick up program”. *The Girls Golf program is designed for the girls; it is their program and their space.* It is a time for them to interact with one another, to grow in ability, to become independent, self sufficient and social in a SAFE *non- invasive* atmosphere.

Distractions, such as golf and behavioral advice from parents during this program is not only confusing for all who are within hearing range but it also sets a mood of disrespect for those who are *Volunteering* their time.

Telling a child what they have *done wrong* with each swing of the golf club is not productive. Knowing and teaching what is *correct* and imparting that to a student is the difference between success and failure for an instructor and the student. Support the child by taking them to practice and allowing them to accept professional advice.
